Attendance

- Attendance is **ESSENTIAL** to succeed in school!
- After 8:30 am student will be considered **TARDY**.
- After **three tardies** your child will **receive a detention**.
- After **three detentions** your child's privilege to attend a school event will be revoked.

Parents must depart from the building at 8 AM

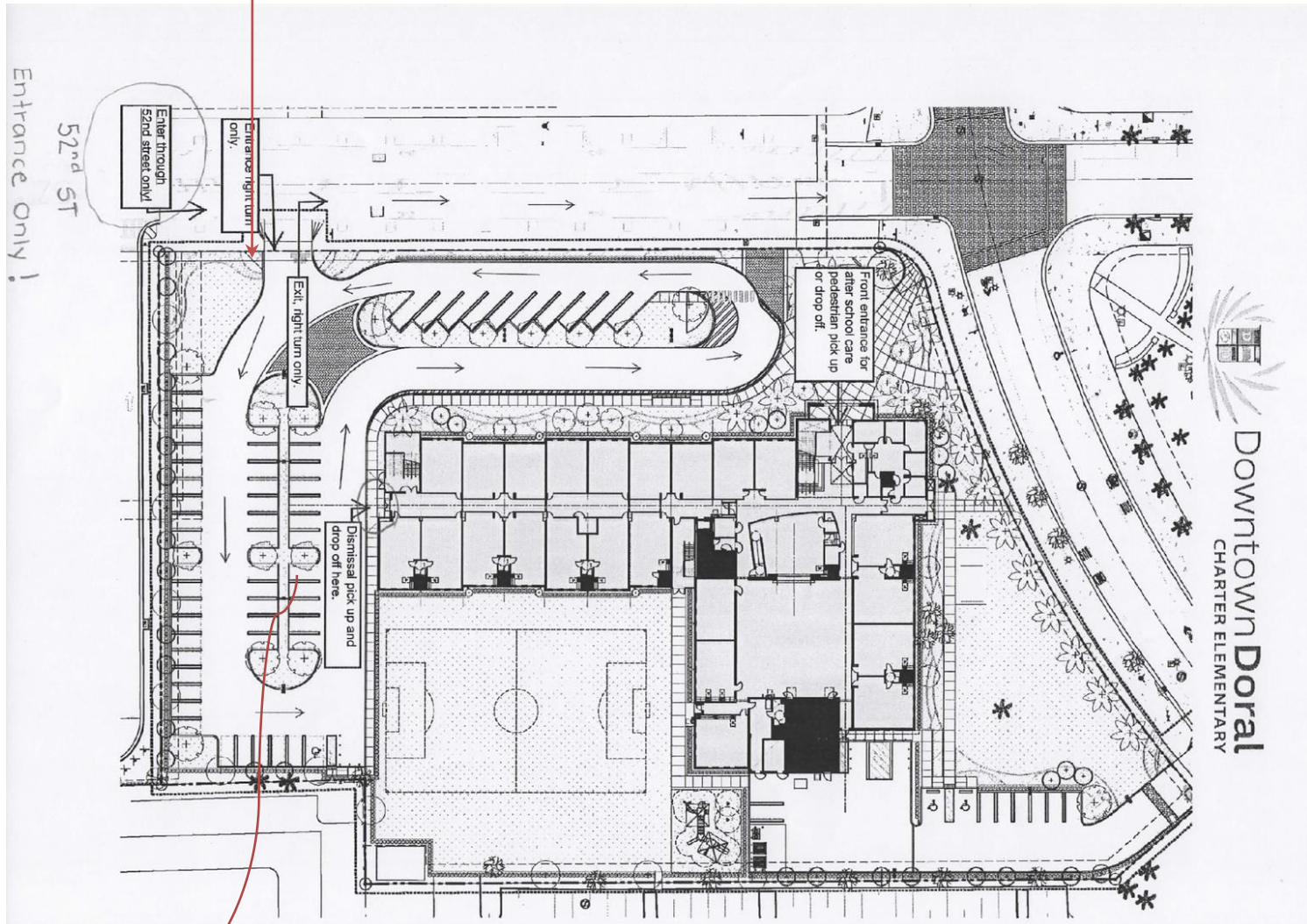
Child will wait in the cafeteria until 8:15 AM

Dismissal Procedure

Two Dismissal Options:

1. Student Pick- Up
2. Drive-Thru

to pick up your child.**



Dismissal



No dismissal is permitted half an hour before the end of the school day, unless authorized by administration. (2:30 PM)

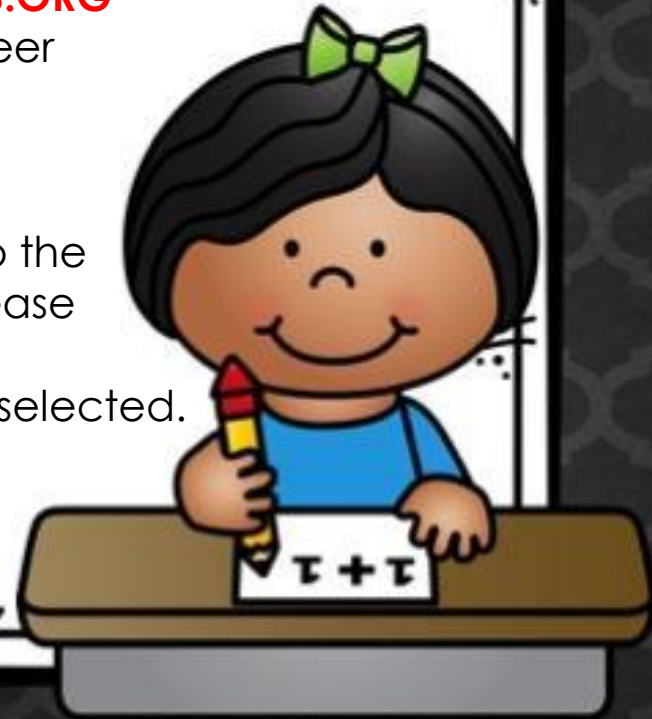

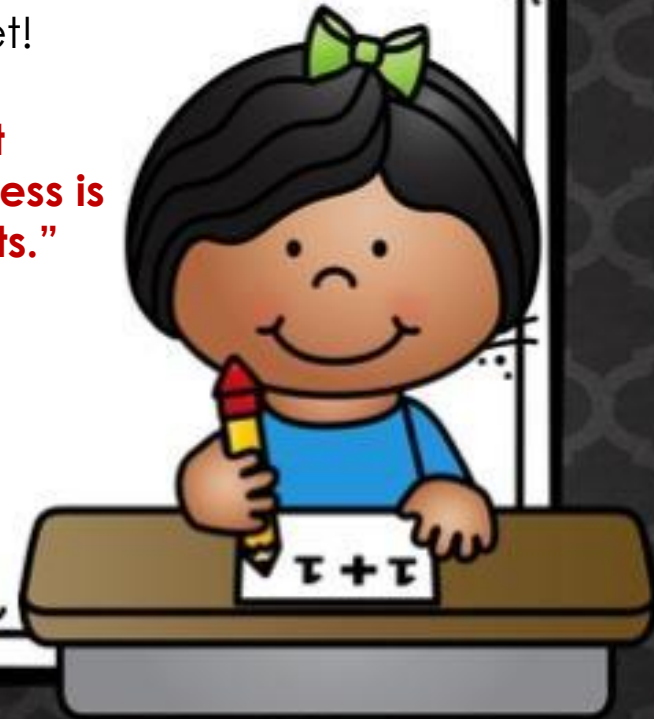

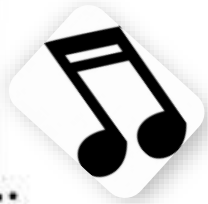

30 minutes content and 30 minutes of reading



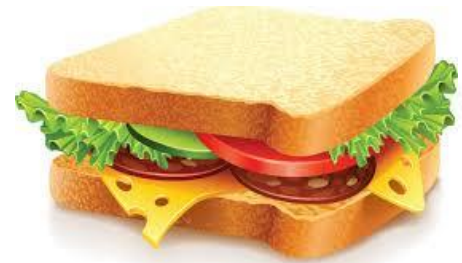
Breakfast
